TASTING NOTES

The Path Cabernet Sauvignon is a bright and easy drinking wine, perfect for everyday enjoyment. Aromas of freshly picked boysenberry, ripe plum along with notes of savory smoked meat, and touches of spiced tea lead a plush and juicy palate. Flavors of black cherry, pomegranate, and dusty cocoa are supported by well-integrated, smooth tannins and leaves a long, flavorful finish.

APPELLATION

In crafting our 2018 The Path Cabernet Sauvignon, our winemakers sourced grapes from throughout California's prime grape growing regions. Known for its abundant sunshine, which helps to ensure a reliable extended growing season, the "Golden State" has become an American winemaking mecca on par with the other great wine regions of the world. California boasts nearly 100 American Viticulture Areas (AVAs) that encompass over a half million acres of vineyards, supporting a diverse varietal mix. Cool climate varieties like Chardonnay and Pinot Noir thrive in the fog-bathed coastal areas, while the warmer inland valleys provide the perfect conditions for heartier heat loving varieties like Cabernet Sauvignon, Petite Sirah, Zinfandel, and Sauvignon Blanc.
